### Fire safety

With a hot weekend forecast, we remind all residents that for the safety of you, your neighbours and your building, you should not use any kind of barbeque on your balcony or rooftop terrace.

Communal doors should never be wedged open, even in warm weather – they are fire doors for your protection so must stay shut. We rely on you to ensure they remain shut.

We'd also like to remind you not to store items outside your front doors or inside communal intake cupboards – this is a fire safety precaution.

We are checking flat entrance doors to ensure fire safety. If an assessor visits, please provide access – all assessors should provide ID.

#### Gas safety

The safety of you and your neighbours is extremely important. We will continue to carry out essential gas safety checks. Engineers from our gas contractor FDH wear PPE and will follow all guidance.

## Communal areas and noise

Please make sure you dispose of all recycling, general waste and bulk rubbish appropriately. Speak to your local council for their bulk rubbish pick up service. For advice on noise nuisance, please <u>look at our website</u>.
